"as to the Law a Pharisee"

• <u>Religious Practice</u> -

"as to zeal, a persecutor of the church"

## "Treasures" of a Wasted Life (4-6)

• Moral Lifestyle -

"as to the righteousness which is in the Law, found blameless"

#### • The Knowledge of Jesus -

"More than that, I count all things to be loss in view of the surpassing value of knowing Christ Jesus, my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them but rubbish so that I may gain Christ, and may be found in Him"

#### • The Righteousness of Jesus -

"not having a righteousness of my own derived from the Law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which comes from God on the basis of faith"

- The Power of Jesus -
- "that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection"
- <u>The Fellowship of Jesus</u> –

"And the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death."
