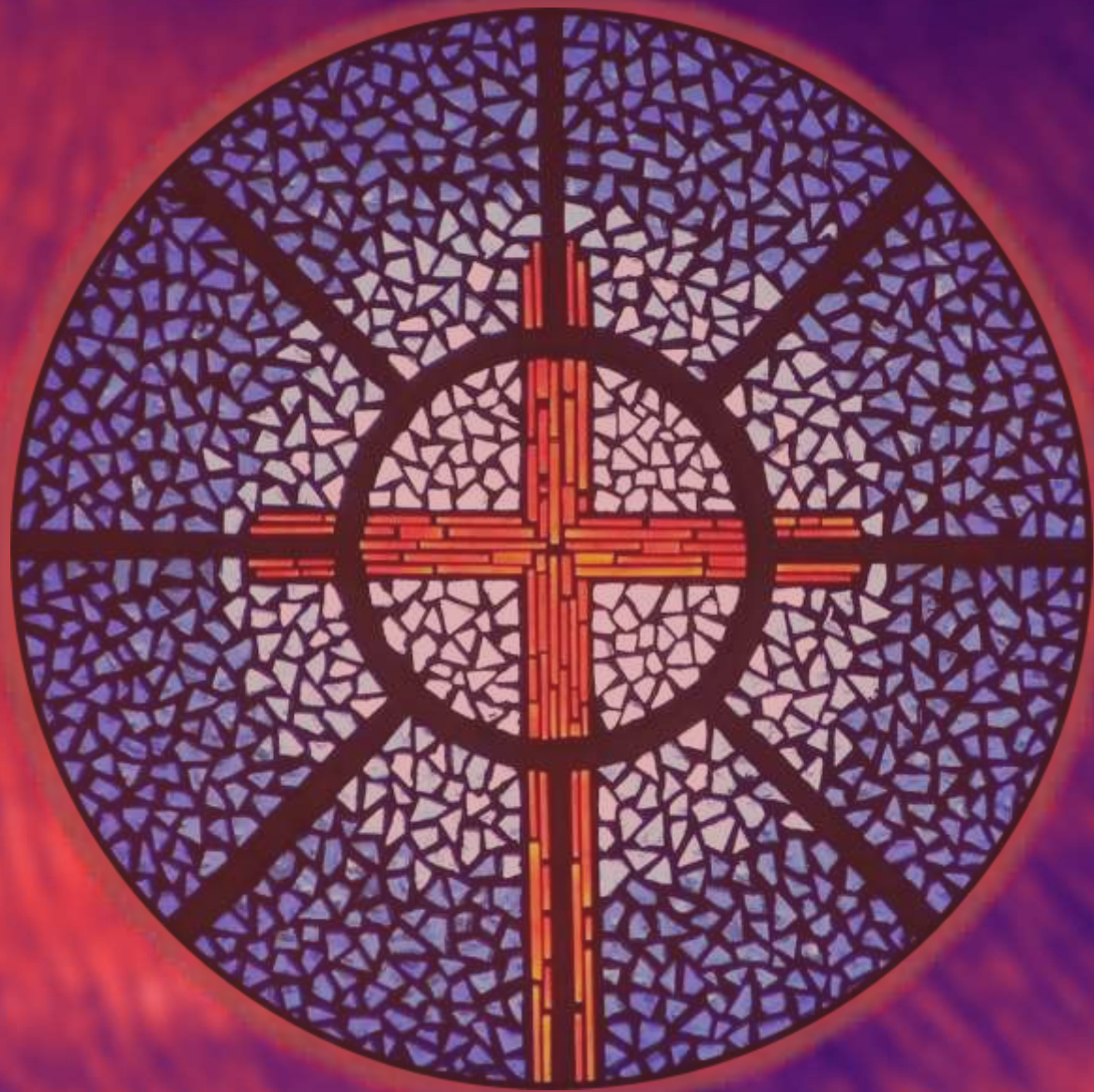

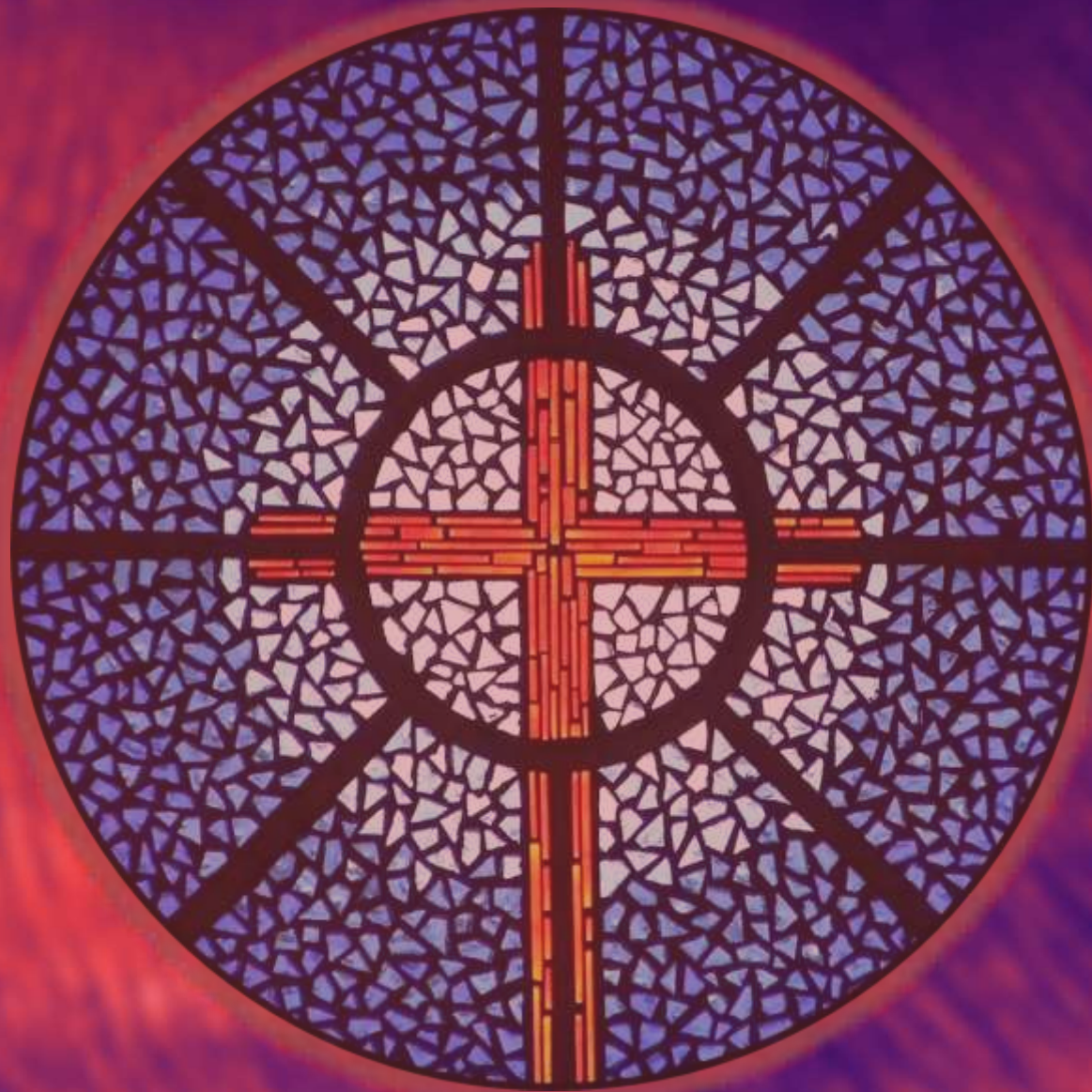

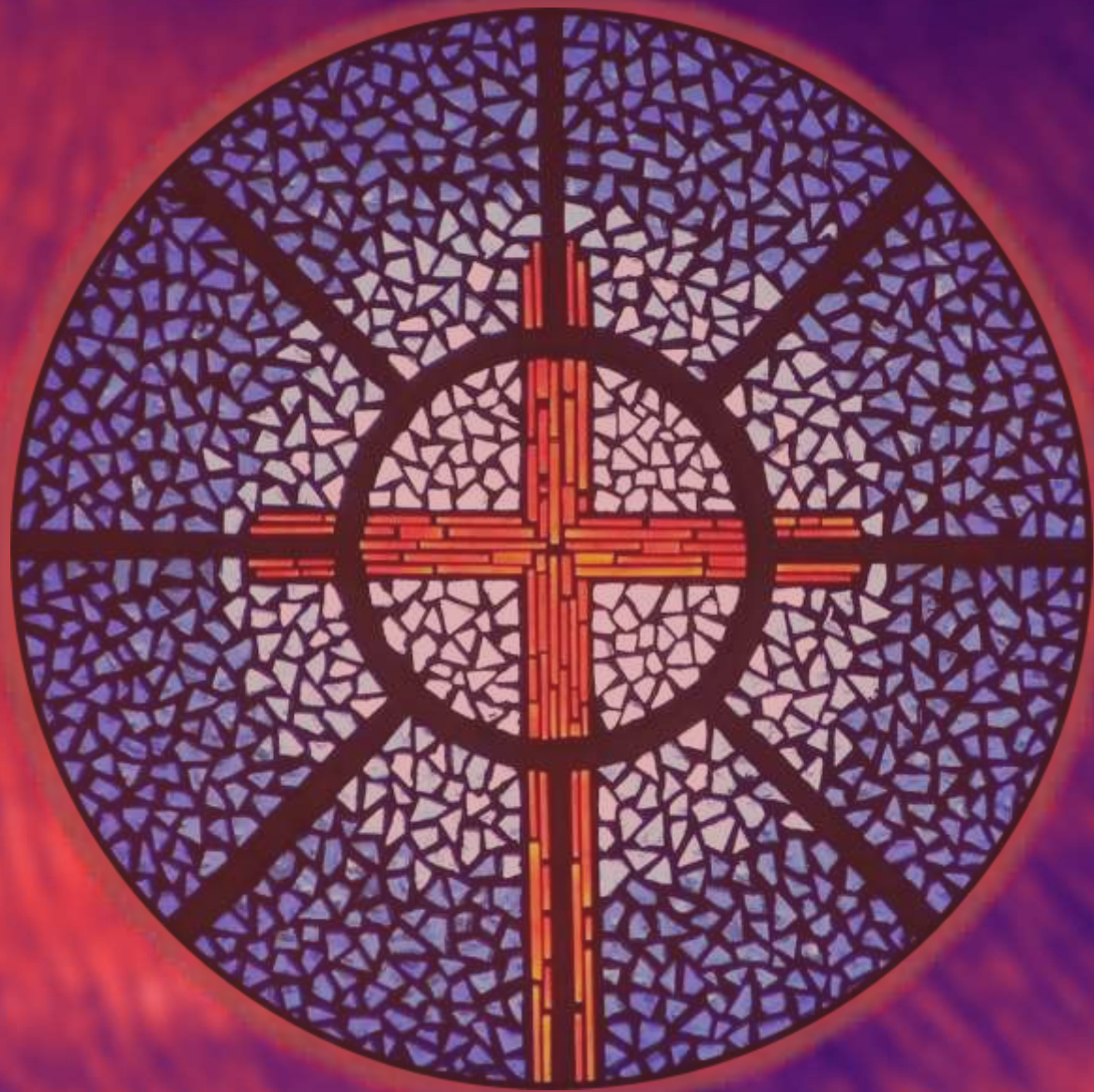


A Testimony of Unending Love

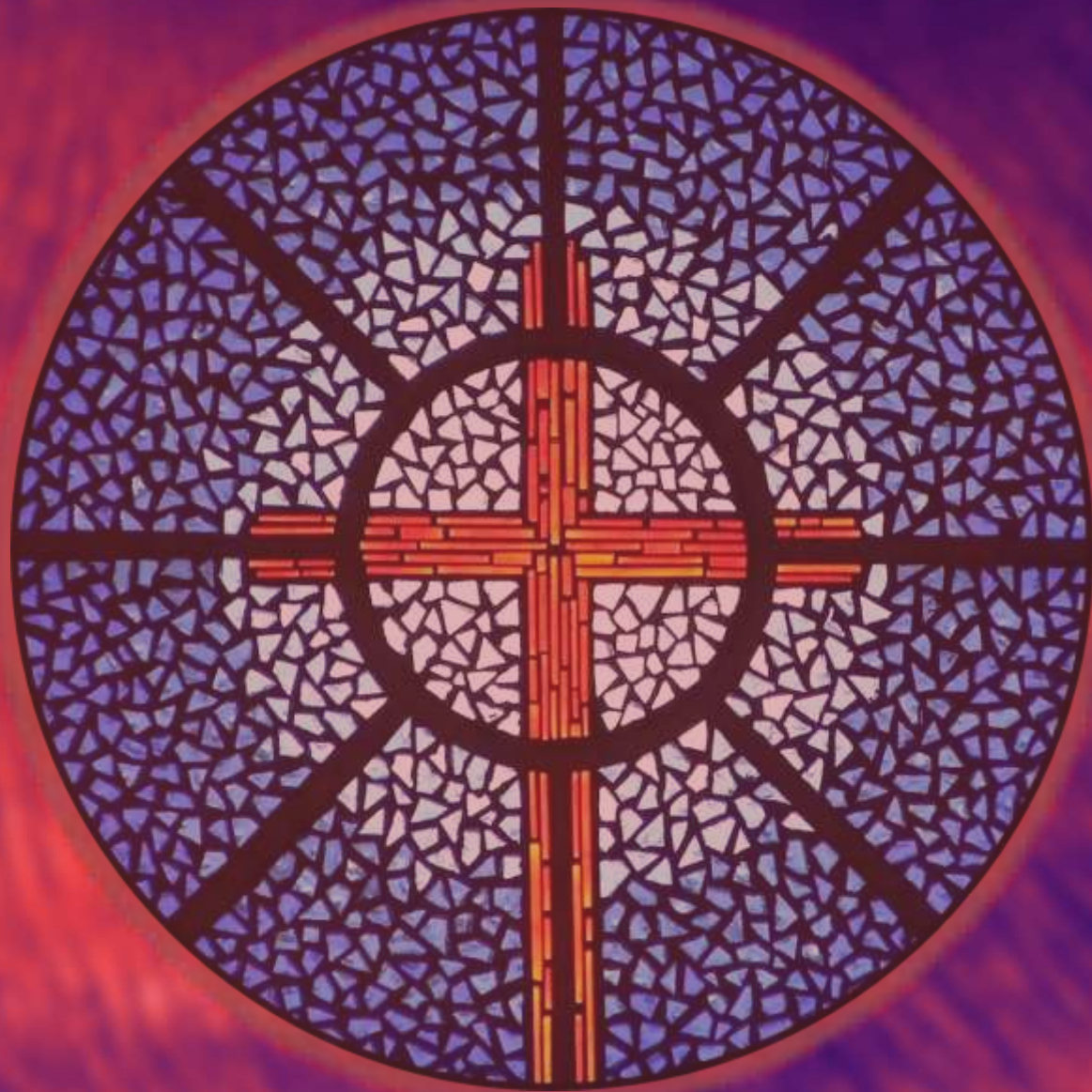


A Testimony of Unfailing Devotion

Demands my soul my life my all

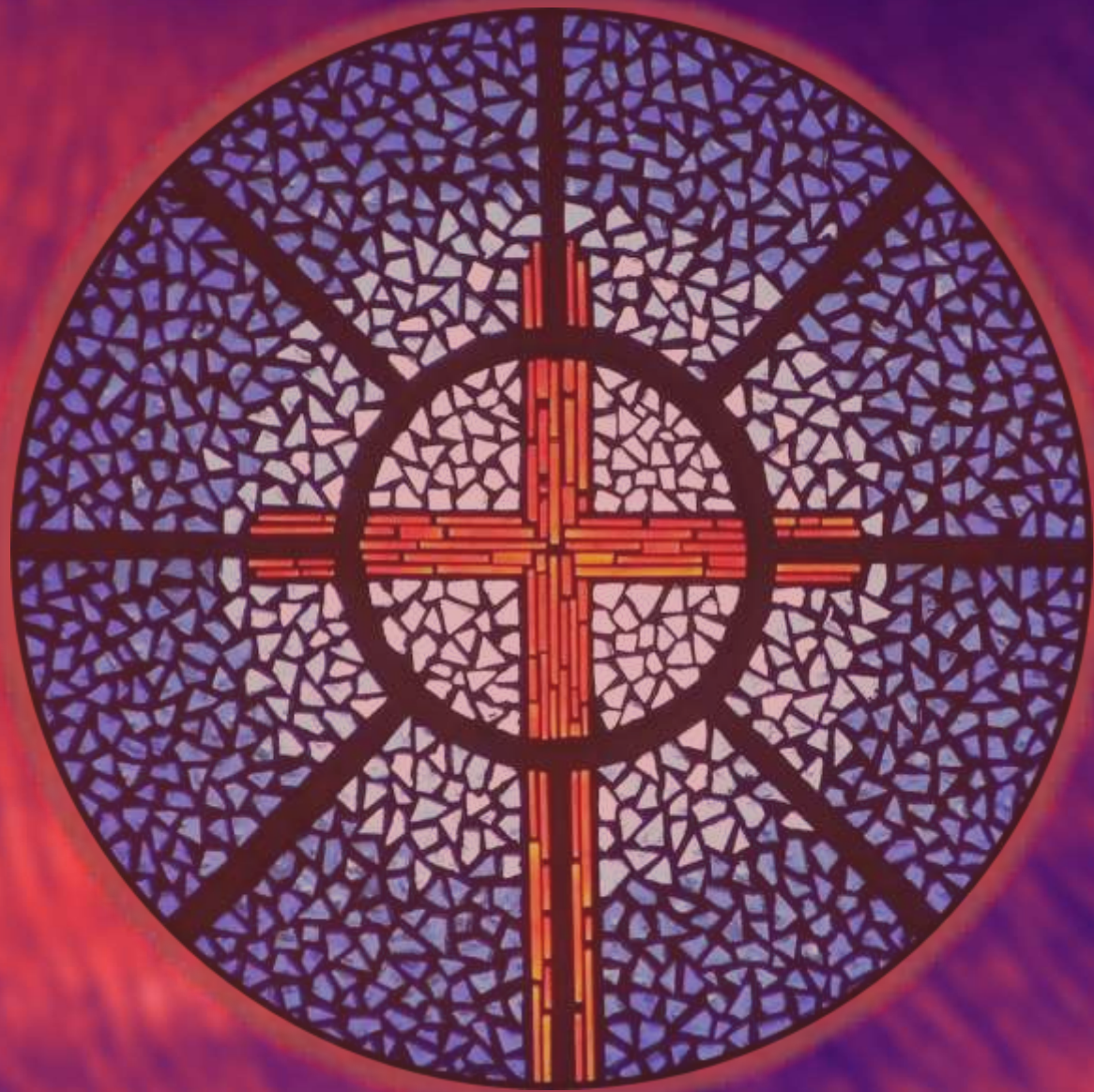
