"So they made Him a supper, and Martha was serving . . ."

### **MEASURED BY SACRIFICE (12:3)**

"Mary then took a pound of very costly perfume of pure nard, and anointed the feet of Jesus and wiped His feet with her hair; and the house was filled with the fragrance of the perfume."

# REVEALED IN OBEDIENCE (12:4-8)

"But Judas Iscariot, one of His disciples, who was intending to betray Him, said, 'Why was this perfume not sold for three hundred denaraii and given to poor people?' Now he said this, not because he was concerned about the poor, but because he was a thief . . . "

#### **FOCUSED ON JESUS (12:9)**

"The large crowd of the Jews then learned that He was there; and they came, not for Jesus sake only, but that they might also see Lazarus, whom He raised from the dead."

## GROUNDED IN TRUTH (12:10,11)

"But the chief priests planned to put Lazarus to death also; because on account of him many of the Jews were going away and were believing in Jesus.'
