A VICTORIOUS PERSON

“If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; from now on you have known Him, and have seen Him. Phillip said to Him, ‘Lord, show us the Father, and it is enough for us.’ Jesus said to him, ‘Have I been so long with you, and yet you have not come to know Me, Phillip? He who has seen me has seen the Father, how can you say, ‘Show us the Father? . . . ”

A VICTORIOUS PERSON (cont.)

“ . . . Do you not believe that that I am in the Father, and the Father is in me? The words that I say to you I do not speak on My own initiative, but the Father abiding in Me does His works. Believe in me that I am in the Father and the Father is in Me; otherwise believe because of the works themselves.”

A VICTORIOUS POWER

“Truly, truly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do, he will do also; and greater works than these he will do; because I go to the Father.”

- ***“the works that I do”*** - seek and save the lost
- ***“greater works”*** – quantity not quality

A VICTORIOUS PROVISION

“Whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask anything in My name, I will do it.”
