
Titus 1: 1-9

Godly Leaders



The Heart of a Godly Leader (1:1-4)

Committed to serving Jesus — "bond-servant" Committed to the mission of Jesus - "for the faith of those chosen of God" Committed to the message of Jesus – "the proclamation with which I was entrusted" Committed to the command of Jesus – "my true child," in a common faith"

The Character of a Godly Leader (1:5-9)

expense

"above reproach" - "blameless," having integrity
"husband of one wife" — a" one-woman man," devoted to wife
"having children who believe" — able to lead his family
"God's steward" — caring for the household of God
"not self-willed" — not asserting his will at other's
```

The Character of a Godly Leader (1:5-9) (cont.)

- "not quick tempered" not easily provoked, critical, negative
- "not addicted to wine" not controlled by substances "not pugnacious" not a fighter, not leading by coercion
- "not fond of sordid gain" not seeking wealth by any means

The Character of a Godly Leader (1:5-9) (cont.)

- "hospitable" giving encouragement and help to the needy
- "loving what is good" positive, preoccupied with what is good
- "sensible" leading a consistent, prioritized life
- "just" fair, clear, unchanging standards
- "devout" obeying God's will from the heart

The Character of a Godly Leader (1:5-9) (cont.)

- "self-controlled" not dominated by selfish passions "holding fast to the faithful word" devoted to the Word of God
- "able to exhort in sound doctrine" giving biblical instruction
- "able to refute those who contradict" speaking against error
