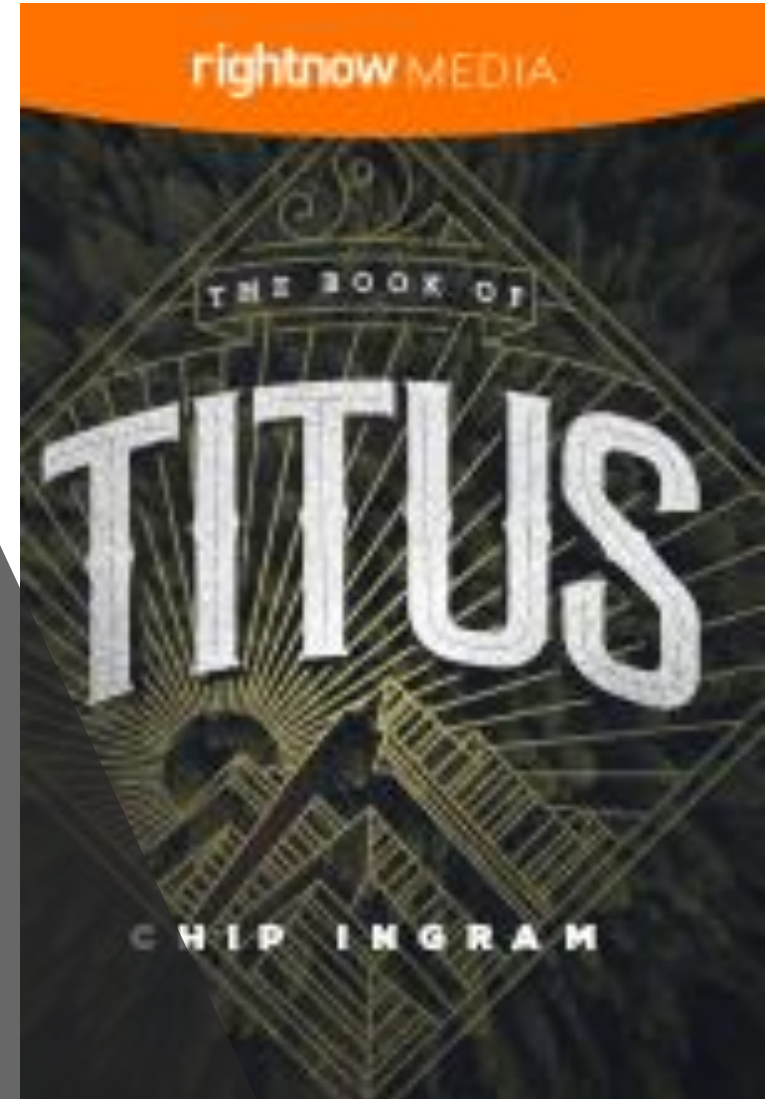


# Titus 1: 10-16

# A Description of False Teachers

*“rebellious”* – not submissive

*“empty talkers”* - produce no goodness

*“deceivers”* - others and themselves

*“those of the circumcision”* – false gospel

*“upsetting whole families”* – subtly destructive

*“for the sake of sordid gain”* – wrong motives

*“Cretans . . .”* - not led of the Holy Spirit

# Dealing with False Teachers (vs. 13-15)

Do not ignore them

Do not excuse them

Do not accommodate them

# Identifying False Teachers

*“They profess to know God, but by their deeds they deny Him, being detestable and disobedient and worthless for any good deed.”*
