
Titus 2: 1-8

Older Men (vs 2)

```
"temperate" – lit. free from intoxication, self-controlled, stable, moderation

"dignified" - serious-minded, worthy of respect

"sensible" - self- controlled

"sound in faith, in love, in perseverance" - to hold up under
```

Older Women (vs. 3-4)

```
"reverent in their behavior" - appropriate to the temple

"not malicious gossips" (diabolos) — used of Satan

"not enslaved to much wine" - under the influence of the

Holy Spirit
```

"teaching what is good" — bring to one's senses
"so that they may encourage the young women to love their husbands, to love their children"

Young Women (vs 5)

```
"sensible" - self-controlled
"pure" – holy, set apart
"workers at home" - God, home, and family are
    priorities
"kind" - manifesting the fruit of the Spirit
"subject to their own husbands" - submissive
```

Young Men (vs 6-8)

"Likewise" — men need to be taught also "urge" — strongly entreat "sensible" - self-controlled "in all things" — in every area of life (vs 7-8) - Titus is to be their example
