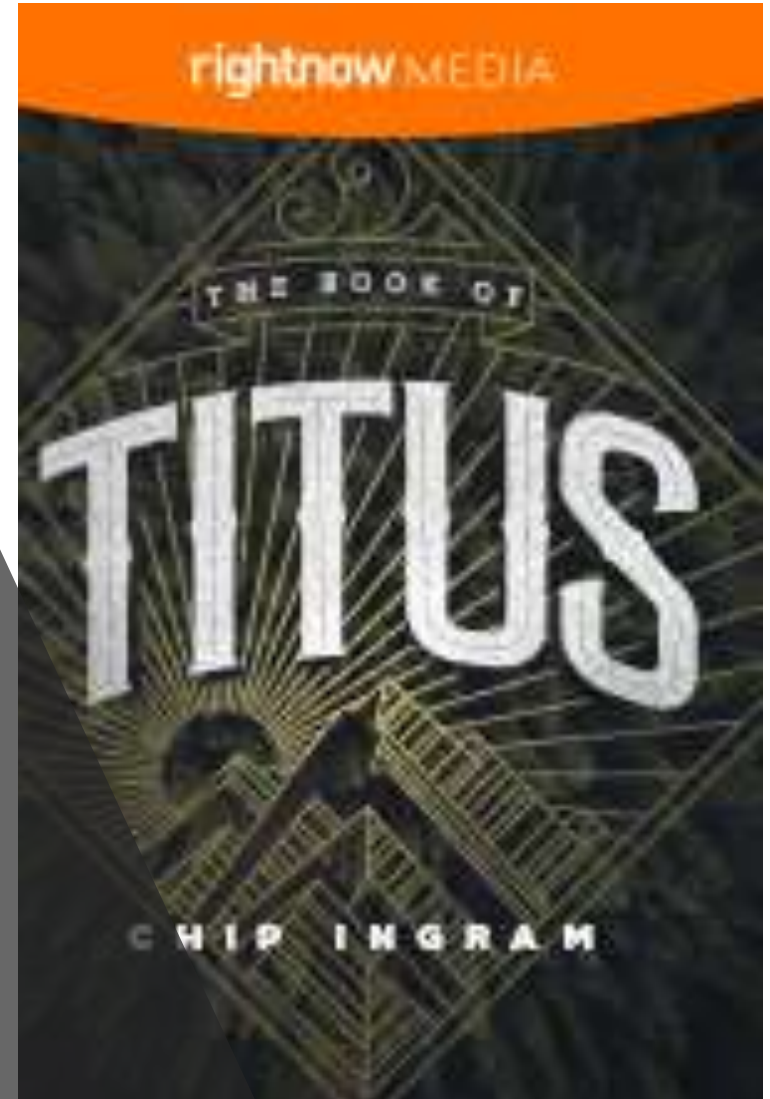

# Older Men (vs 2)

*“temperate”* – lit. free from intoxication, self-controlled,  
stable, moderation

*“dignified”* - serious-minded, worthy of respect

*“sensible”* - self- controlled

*“sound in faith, in love, in perseverance”* - to hold up  
under

# Older Women (vs. 3-4)

*“reverent in their behavior”* - appropriate to the temple

*“not malicious gossips”* (diabolos) — used of Satan

*“not enslaved to much wine”* - under the influence of the  
Holy Spirit

*“teaching what is good”* — bring to one’s senses

*“so that they may encourage the young women to love  
their husbands, to love their children”*

# Young Women (vs 5)

*“sensible”* – self-controlled

*“pure”* – holy, set apart

*“workers at home”* – God, home, and family are priorities

*“kind”* - manifesting the fruit of the Spirit

*“subject to their own husbands”* - submissive

## Young Men (vs 6-8)

*“Likewise”* – men need to be taught also

*“urge”* – strongly entreat

*“sensible”* – self-controlled

*“in all things”* – in every area of life

(vs 7-8) - Titus is to be their example
