
Titus 3: 1-2 Living by Grace in the World



BE OBEDIENT TO AUTHORITY "Remind them to be subject to rulers, to authorities, to be obedient . . ."

"Remind them . . ." – a command, continually be reminding them

III. Jesus and the poll tax

BE HELPFUL TO OTHERS "... to be ready for every good deed ..."

"ready" – "eager"

III. Jesus and the feeding of the multitudes

BE GRACIOUS IN SPEECH

"... to malign no one ..."

"malign" – to slander, curse, or treat with contempt

III. Jesus' gracious words

BE FRIENDLY TO ALL

"... to be peaceable to all ..."

"peaceable" - friendly and peaceful toward the lost rather than quarrelsome and belligerent

III. Jesus and the tax collector

BE GENTLE TOWARD EVERYONE

"...gentle..."

"gentle" – sweet reasonableness, patient and forbearing toward others

III. Jesus and the adulterous woman

BE GENUINELY HUMBLE IN RELATION TO GOD AND OTHERS "... showing every consideration for all men."

"consideration" – humility, meekness
