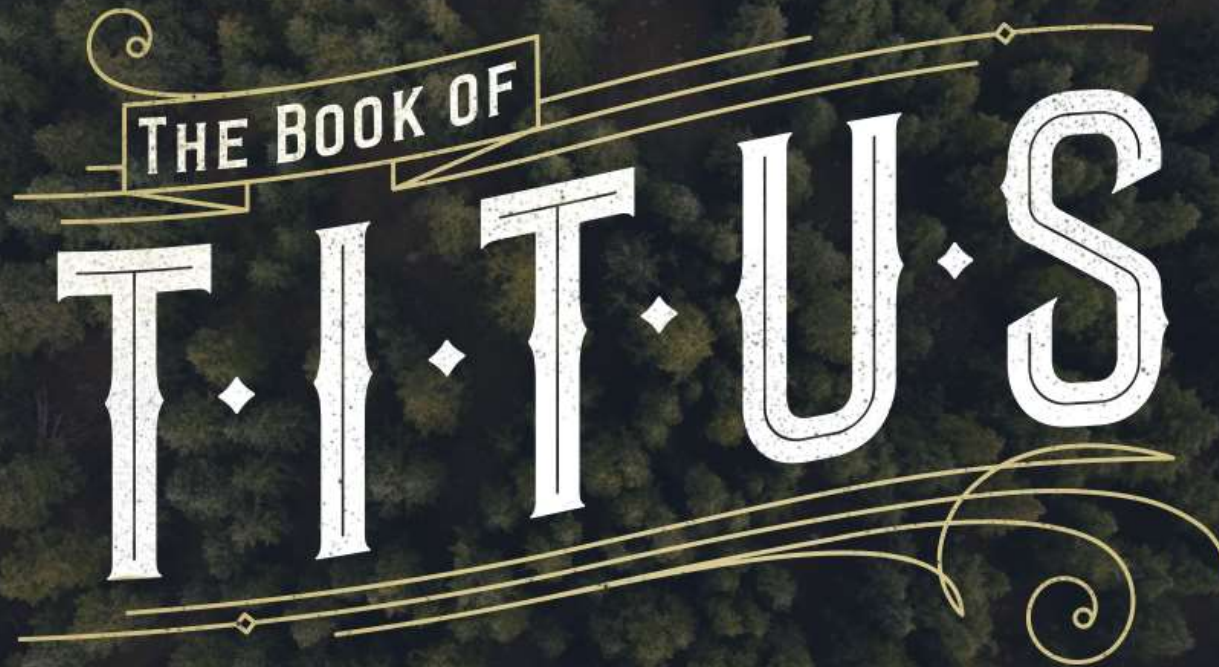

# Living by Grace in the **World**



# BE OBEDIENT TO AUTHORITY

*“Remind them to be subject to rulers, to authorities, to be obedient . . .”*

*“Remind them . . .”* – a command, continually be reminding them

III. Jesus and the poll tax

# BE HELPFUL TO OTHERS

*“ . . . to be ready for every good deed . . . ”*

*“ready” – “eager”*

III. Jesus and the feeding of the multitudes

# BE GRACIOUS IN SPEECH

*“ . . . to malign no one . . . ”*

*“malign”* – to slander, curse, or treat with contempt

III. Jesus' gracious words

# BE FRIENDLY TO ALL

*“ . . . to be peaceable to all . . . ”*

*“peaceable”* - friendly and peaceful toward the lost rather than quarrelsome and belligerent

III. Jesus and the tax collector

# BE GENTLE TOWARD EVERYONE

“... *gentle* ...”

“*gentle*” – sweet reasonableness, patient and forbearing toward others

III. Jesus and the adulterous woman

# BE GENUINELY HUMBLE IN RELATION TO GOD AND OTHERS

*“... showing every consideration for all men.”*

*“consideration”* – humility, meekness
