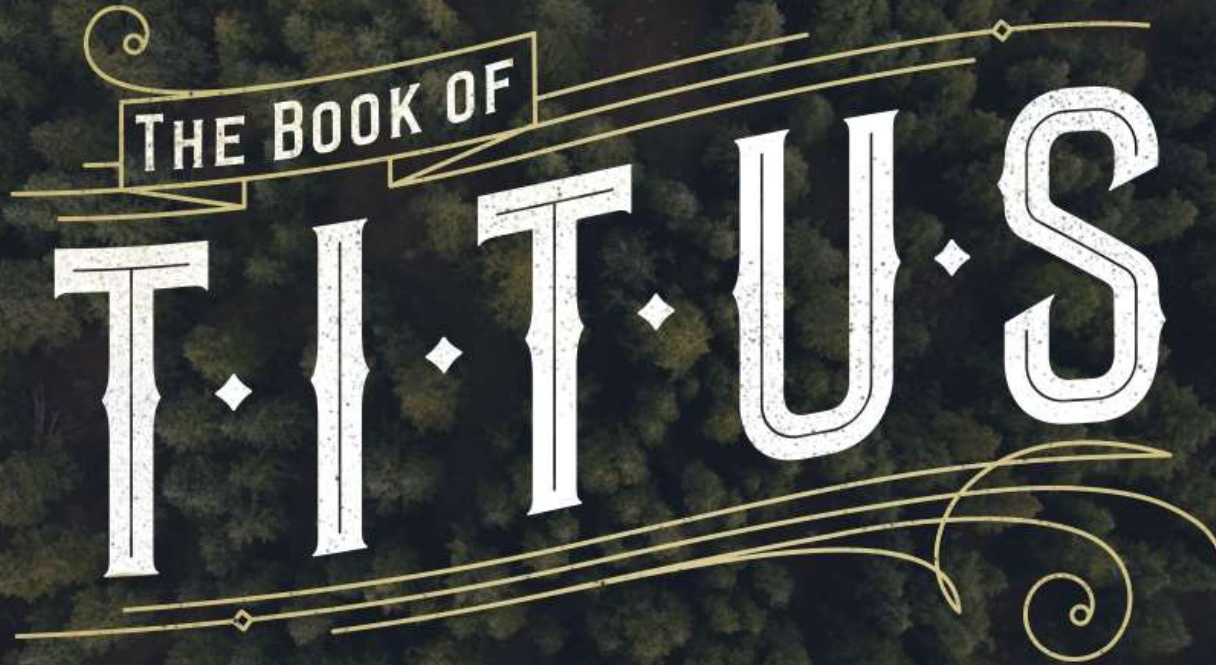


Titus 3: 3-15

Remembering Good Works



REMEMBER WHAT WE ONCE WERE (vs. 3)

“foolish” – ignorant, lacking understanding

“disobedient” – rebellious, resisting God and His will

“deceived”

“enslaved to various lusts and pleasures”

“spending our life in malice and envy” – wickedness
and ill-will

“hateful, hating one another”

REMEMBER WHAT GOD HAS DONE FOR US

(vs. 4-7)

“God has loved us”

“God has saved us”

“God has changed us”

“God has adopted us”

REMEMBER WHAT GOD HAS CALLED US TO DO (vs. 8)

“This is a trustworthy statement; and concerning these things I want you to speak confidently, so that those who have believed God may be careful to engage in good deeds. These things are good and profitable for all men.”

REMEMBER TO STAY FOCUSED (vs. 9-11)

“avoid foolish controversies and genealogies”

“and strife” – personal rivalries

“and disputes about the Law” – legalistic arguments

“reject a factious man” – contentious, not submitting to the word or godly leadership
