DISTRACTIONS

"Brethren, I do not regard myself as having laid hold of (it) yet; but one thing (I do)"

- the importance of "one thing"
- Paul's "one thing" knowing Jesus

DIRECTION

"forgetting what lies behind and reaching forward to what lies ahead"

- "forgetting" not letting the past hinder you
- "reaching" straining
- "forward" the importance of the right direction

DETERMINATION

"I press on . . ."

- to "press on"
 - to exert
 - to endure

DESTINATION

"toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus"

- "toward" to bear down, to fix one's eyes on a goal
- "the prize of the upward call of God" God's call from / to heaven
- "in Christ Jesus" to be with Jesus / to know Him / to be like Him
